1. Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.112 dated 07.07.2022 registered under Section 21 of NDPS Act (Sections 353, 332, 186, 224, 225, 148, 149 IPC added later on) at Police Station City Jalalabad, District Fazilka.
2. Vide order dated 30.05.2023 passed by a Coordinate Bench, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 30.05.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.
5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 30.05.2023 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
