The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No. 0096 dated 25.04.2023 under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Haibowal, District Ludhiana.

2. Vide order dated 04.09.2023 the petitioner had been granted interim anticipatory bail with direction to join investigation and the relevant part of the said order reads as under:-

“learned counsel for the petitioner, while reiterating his submissions made on 30.05.2023 before this Court, submits that the petitioner is ready to join investigation and cooperate with the investigating agency.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 04.09.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ram Krishan, Police Station Haibowal, Ludhiana, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He on further instructions submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 04.09.2023, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Needless to say, in case the petitioner misuses the concession of bail granted to him, the State would be at liberty to seek cancellation of the bail granted to her.
