1. This petition is filed seeking quashing of FIR No. 169, dated 3rd October, 2022, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of IPC, 1860 and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014, registered at Police Station Division No.6, District Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar on the basis of compromise.
