The petitioners seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.32 dated 06.03.2023 registered under Sections 323, 325, 341, 506, 120-B IPC, 1860 and Section 307 IPC added later on at Police Station Balongi, District SAS Nagar, Punjab.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 30.05.2023, petitioners have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

An affidavit dated 22.08.2023 by way of an affidavit of Karan Singh Sandhu, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Kharar-I, District SAS Nagar has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 30.05.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall keep on
