HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

1. Petitioner (Annu Rani) has filed the present petition under Section 438 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking grant of anticipatory bail in Complaint No. NACT-70-2018 dated 02.02.2018 titled as ***“Pawan Kumar Vs. Annu Rani”***, filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, pending before the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jind.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the proceedings under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act are pending before the trial Court for 03.06.2023 and the petitioner is ready and willing to amicably settle the dispute with respondent No.2/complainant and in order to show her *bona fide*, she shall pay an amount of Rs.40,000/- out of the cheque amount of Rs.80,000/- to respondent No.2/complainant, tomorrow (03.06.2023) before the trial Court.

3. Notice of motion.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Ram Kumar Singla, Deputy

Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1/State.

5. Keeping in view above submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner and also the nature of order to be passed, there is no need to serve respondent No.2 at this stage. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the trial Court on the date already fixed, i.e. 03.06.2023, and pay an amount of Rs.40,000/- to respondent No.2/complainant. In case the petitioner appears before the trial Court on 03.06.2023 and pays an amount of Rs.40,000/- to the complainant then the trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail and the trial Court shall further afford opportunity to the parties to amicably resolve the dispute.

6. Present petition is accordingly disposed of in the aforesaid terms.

7. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
