The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No. 4 not to block the ingress and egress to the Scooter/Car parking stand being run by the petitioner, at Bus Stand, Amritsar.

It is informed by the petitioner that a Civil Suit for injunction has already been filed by the petitioner. A copy of the plaint has been attached as Annexure P-4. An application under Order 39 Rule 1 & 2 is also pending consideration before the Civil Court.

In view of the aforesaid, counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition at this stage and seeks withdrawal of the same in order to pursue his remedies before the Civil Court in the pending Civil Suit.
