This is a petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 10.05.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Additional District Judge, Ludhiana, whereby the application filed by the petitioner under Order 1 Rule 9 read with Order 7 Rule 11 of the Code of Civil Procedure, seeking rejection of the plaint, has been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the main suit, from which the present petition has arisen, itself stands dismissed in default, even for the second time.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered as infructuous. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to get it revived, if the need arises.
