LISA GILL, J.

1. Prayer in this writ petition is for directing respondents to settle petitioner's account and allow him to deposit balance amount in installments.
2. Learned counsel for respondent – Bank submits that though time had been sought on last date of hearing to file reply, she has now been instructed by Sh. Amritpal Singh, Deputy Manager, (MIS), SBI Jalandhar to submit that this writ petition is infact rendered infructuous as auction of the property in question has been conducted on 27.07.2022 and sale certificate issued as well. Possession of the property had been taken on 22.04.2023.
3. Today, none appears on behalf of the petitioner.
4. Be that as it may, we do not find any justification for continuance of present proceedings, in view of categoric statement by learned counsel for respondent – Bank.

5. Writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of as infructuous with liberty to petitioner to file appropriate application within four weeks in case, any incorrect fact has been set forth before this Court.
