VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction directing the respondent-commission not to deduct 5 marks of the petitioner for no Government job in the family of her in laws, in terms of Clause 2.3 for the selection on the post of Female Constable against the Advertisement No.4/2020 dated 30.12.2020 category No.2 (Annexure P-1) and place the petitioner at the appropriate place in the final selection list dated 17.06.2022 (Annexure P-19). Further, prayer has also been made for issuance of directions to the respondent Commission to award

five marks for fatherless (orphan) to the petitioner in terms of the advertisement.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that for the grievances raised by the petitioner in the present writ petition, the petitioner had given a representation dated 28.01.2022 (Annexure P-18) to the Chairman, Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula and she would be satisfied at this stage, in case, the competent authority of Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula, takes a final decision on representation dated 28.01.2022 (Annexure P-18) in a time bound manner, in accordance with law and in case the pleas raised by the petitioner are found to be meritorious, then to grant necessary relief, in accordance with law.

3. Learned State Counsel has submitted that the competent authority of Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula would consider the said representation dated 28.01.2022 (Annexure P-18) in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.

4. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of with direction to the competent authority of Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula to consider representation dated 28.01.2022 (Annexure P-18) in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order and in case, the pleas raised by the petitioner are

found to be meritorious, then the competent authority of Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula, would grant necessary relief, in accordance with law and in case, the competent authority is of the opinion that the pleas raised by the petitioner are not meritorious, then a speaking order rejecting the same be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.

5. This Court has not opined on the merits of the case and the competent authority of Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula, would consider the case of the petitioner independently and in accordance with law.
