HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

The present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is filed on behalf of the petitioners seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to transfer the investigation, in case FIR No.214 dated 14.12.2017, under Sections 120-B and 306 IPC, registered at Police Station Samana, District Patiala, to some higher official. Further prayer is made to protect life and liberty of the petitioners as well as son of petitioner No.1, namely Simranjeet Singh, at the hands of respondents No.4 to 11.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Paramjit Singh, submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the challan in this case has already been presented and even the charges have been framed. Learned State counsel further submits that

the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala, vide order dated 03.01.2023, has allowed the application filed under Section 319 Cr.P.C., for summoning Jatinder Singh, Baljit Singh & Bhupinder Singh, sons of Gurnam Singh; Kawaljit Kaur @ Dimple wife of Tarlok Singh; Davinder Singh son of Tarlok Singh and Paramjot Singh son of Didar Singh, all residents of Village Bijalpur, Police Station Sadar Samana, District Patiala, along with Tarlok Singh, who is already facing trial, as accused under Section 306 IPC, in FIR No.214 dated 14.12.2017. Copy thereof is supplied in Court today, which is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the aforesaid submission made by learned State counsel, the instant petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
