1. The petitioner has assailed the orders passed by the Courts below vide which interim relief has been awarded in favour of the respondent in the proceedings as per the provisions of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act (for short 'the Act').

2. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the respondent has withdrawn the application under Section 12 of the Act on 28.09.2021 and consequently the present petition has become infructuous.

3. In view of the categoric assertion made by learned counsel for the respondent, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

4. As none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner, she shall be at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition within a period of three months, if the aforesaid assertion of learned counsel for the respondent is found to be factually incorrect.
