1. Petitioners have approached this Court inter-alia for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside result dated 04.02.2022 and 16.02.2023, Annexures P-20 and P-26, respectively, pertaining to the post of Veterinary Livestock Development Assistant (VLDA) in BCB category against Advertisement No.15/2019 dated 07.09.2019, Annexure P-13.

2. Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners participated in the selection process for the post of VLDA and their roll numbers were placed in the waiting list as is depicted from the result, Annexure P-21. Counsel submits that private respondents No.3 and 4, who have been selected for the post in the BCB category, have been wrongly granted five marks under Socio Economic Category as their respective spouses are in Government service. Counsel submits that the petitioners have submitted a complaint dated 19.04.2022, Annexure P-24, to the Director General,

Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, which has been forwarded to respondent No.2 by communication dated 18.08.2022, Annexure P-25. Counsel submits that no action has been taken on the complaint and the petitioners would be satisfied in case the respondents enquire into it.

3. Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 and 2 only at this stage.
4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.
5. Given the nature of order being passed, this Court does not deem it necessary to call for a return from the official respondents.
6. Having heard counsel for the parties, but without examining the grievance of the petitioners as raised in the writ petition or in the complaint, Annexure P-24, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondents to examine the complaint, Annexure P-24, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. If any action is taken or order is passed on the complaint, same be communicated to the petitioners.
