The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing case/complaint No.144 dated 15.04.2023 registered under Section 160(2) of the Railway Act, 1989 at Police Station Railway Protection Force, Chandigarh.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 01.06.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.
