JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 is seeking writ of mandamus directing the respondents No.1 to 5 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent No.6.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* contends that petitioner No.1 has got divorce from respondent No.6. The petitioner No.1 is staying separate from respondent No.6, however, he is roaming around the house of the petitioner and harassing her. The petitioner No.1 has filed representation dated 12.05.2023 followed by representation dated 25.05.2023 to Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar seeking protection of their lives and liberty.
3. Learned State counsel, who on advance notice is present in Court assures the Court that jurisdictional authority would look into the representation of the petitioners.
4. In view of the statement of learned State counsel, this Court is sanguine of the fact that competent authority would look into the matter and redress grievance of the petitioners, if found genuine.
5. Disposed of in the above terms.
