Petitioners were earlier declared proclaimed persons in case FIR No.435 dated 23.03.2017 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC registered at Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar vide order dated 01.02.2023. Separate FIR No.92 dated 16.02.2023 under Section 174-A IPC was registered against them at Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar. Petitioners were allowed bail on 16.02.2023. The next date was fixed as 17.04.2023 for consideration of charge in the case under Section 174-A IPC when application for exemption was moved by the two petitioners which was declined by the trial Court. The bail was cancelled and warrants of arrest were issued. Petitioners filed application for anticipatory bail but the same was dismissed on 22.05.2023 by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar.

It is submitted by learned counsel that the two petitioners belong to Maharashtra and due to certain reasons, they could not appear before the Court on 17.04.2023 and, therefore, they had moved

an application for exemption. They are ready to surrender before the trial Court.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Randhir Singh, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent- State.

Petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to surrender before the concerned trial Court on or before 06.08.2023, the date already fixed thereat. On their such appearance, they shall be admitted to bail on furnishing requisite bail bonds. However, petitioners shall deposit an amount of ₹10,000/- each as cost in District Legal Services Authority, Jagadhri. In case petitioners fail to make compliance of any of the directions, this order shall have no effect. If in the meantime, due to warrants of arrest having been issued against the petitioners, they are sought to be arrested, they shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.
