Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are residents of Madhya Pradesh and are being unnecessarily harassed by respondent No.4 on the basis of one false complaint lodged against the petitioners on the behest of respondents No.5 and 6; that being aggrieved, the petitioners have already given representation dated 14.5.2023 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.3 but the police authorities failed to take any action in this regard.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if a time bound direction is given to the official respondents to consider and decide representation dated 14.5.2023 (Annexure P-3).

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. C.L.Pawar, Addl. AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and submitted that in case any complaint/representation(s) has been filed, the concerned authorities will consider and decide the same as

per law.

5. Counsel for the petitioner is agreed to the aforesaid proposal.

In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide representation dated 14.5.2023 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
