DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for regularization of his services in pursuance of the Punjab Govt. Policy dated 18.03.2011 (Annexure P-4) read with instructions dated 17.11.2011 (Annexure P-5) and further to give him all the consequential benefits arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he entered into service as Data Entry Operator initially on daily wages vide order dated 14.12.2007 and was later on converted on contract basis vide order dated 21.04.2008 by the respondent-University and since then service of the petitioner is continuous, uninterrupted and without any break. Learned counsel further contends that petitioner has rendered more than 15 years of service on contract basis and as per Punjab Government policy dated 18.03.2011 read with instructions dated 17.11.2011, petitioner is entitled for regularization of his services. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits

that petitioner has served a Notice of Demand dated 30.03.2023 (Annexure P-7) upon the respondents but the said notice has not been taken into consideration till date and he would be satisfied if the said Notice of Demand is directed to be decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Nitin Kaushal, Advocate has put in apperance, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and does not object to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above and with the consent of both the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the Notice of Demand dated 30.03.2023 (Annexure P-7) submitted by the petitioner, within a period of 8 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
