1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass in the peaceful life of the petitioners.

2. Learned State counsel submits that the statement of petitioners have been recorded in the present case and they submitted that they do not apprehend any threat.
