AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This is the second petition for grant of interim bail to the petitioner for three months in case FIR No. 72 dated 23.5.2020 under Sections 21,22, 25and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Sections 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Mehal Kalan, District Barnala on ground that mother of the petitioner is suffering from Advanced Stage-IV cancer.

Learned counsel for the State while relying upon the pleadings of the reply filed in CRM-23718 of 2023 in CRM-M-34122 of 2021 is not disputing the ailment of the mother of the petitioner.

For the reasons mentioned in the petition, the same is allowed. The petitioner is granted four weeks interim bail on furnishing of bail bond/surety bond to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

The petitioner will surrender back to the jail authorities immediately after completion of four weeks.
