Challenge in the present revision petition is to judgment dated 07.11.2015, vide which the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ambala, while dismissing the appeal filed by the petitioner has affirmed the judgment dated 11.12.20215, rendered by the leaned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ambala, acquitting respondents No. 2 and 3.

The case pertains to the year 2017 and notice is yet to be issued in the same.
