The present petition has been filed for issuance of a direction for quashing of order dated 28.12.2015 (Annexure P-1) issued by respondent no.3 vide which petitioner has been directed to pay the assessed amount of Rs.1,10,689/- for committing alleged theft under Section 135 of the Electricity Act, 2003.

Reply filed on behalf of respondents no.2 and 3 in Court today is taken on record. Copy thereof has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. It has been contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the writ petition has been filed for quashing the provisional assessment order dated 28.12.2015 (Annexure P-1) issued by respondent no.3, whereby the petitioner had been directed to pay the assessed amount of Rs.1,10,689/- for theft of energy under Section 135 of Electricity Act, 2003.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that he has already deposited the assessed amount and that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Counsel for the respondents no.2 and 3 has no objection to the same.
