1. Present civil revision petition has been filed for issuance of a direction to the Family Court, Panchkula to decide the case bearing No. HMA/315/2017 dated 07.10.2017 titled as Deepak Bansal vs. Rupali and another expeditiously.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the divorce petition filed by the petitioner is pending for the last five years but has not reached the logical conclusion so far and keeping in view the pace of the trial, it is not likely to reach the conclusion in near future hence, appropriate direction be given to the Family Court, Panchkula to decide the case bearing HMA No.315 of 2017 dated 07.10.2017 titled as Deepak Bansal vs. Rupali and another within a time bound manner.

3. Though the petition is pending for the last more than five years

but nothing has come on record that the proceedings in the said petition are being delayed in any manner. Proceedings in the petition are being undertaken in accordance with law keeping in view the workload with the concerned Court.

4. Despite recording the said fact, once the petition relates to the family dispute between the parties, the trial Court is requested to ensure the speedy conclusion of the trial even if the said purpose is to be achieved by giving short adjournments.

5. The present civil revision petition is disposed of in above terms.
