HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were claiming promotion to the post of Assistant, which promotion has already been granted to the petitioners during the pendency of the petition but claim of the petitioners with regard to retrospective promotion has not been decided, hence, the petitioners intend to approach the respondents with the said prayer by filing appropriate representation and the respondents be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner so that the petitioners do not suffer any prejudice.

2. Learned State counsel submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioners claiming ante dated promotion to the post of Assistant, the same will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the

receipt of any such claim.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to file appropriate representation with the respondents.
