HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J.(Oral)

1. The present writ petition has been filed with a prayer that the respondents be directed to regularize the services of the petitioners in view of the letter dated 22.01.2019 (Annexure P-7) by which, the respondent No.4 had recommended the case of the petitioners to respondent NO.3 for regularization of their services.
2. The counsel for the petitioners pleads that the petitioners are claiming the benefit of letter dated 22.01.2019 (Anenxure P-7) in which their names were recommended for regularization of their services.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the said grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioners through legal notice dated 04.11.2022 (Annexure P-11) served upon the respondents and the same is still pending consideration before the authorities concerned and the petitioners will be satisfied if a time bound direction is given to respondents/competent authorities to decide the above legal notice

(Annexure P-11) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Notice of motion to respondents.
5. Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana-respondents and raises no objection for deciding the representation in a time bound manner.
6. Learned State counsel submits that in case the said legal notice dated 04.11.2022 (Annexure P-11) has not already been decided by respondents so far, the same will be considered and decided within a period of eight weeks after passing a speaking order, from receipt of certified copy of this order and in case after the decision of the said legal notice, any benefit accrues to the petitioners, the same will also be extended to them within a period of four weeks thereafter.
7. Keeping in view the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further orders are required to be passed.
