DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel contends that his vehicle i.e. Truck Tata bearing registration No.PB-12-Y-6670 was impounded during investigation of case arising out of FIR No.18 dated 05.07.2022 registered at Police Station SSOC Amritsar, District Intelligence Wing (Amritsar) under Sections 18, 25, 29 of NDPS Act. Petitioner applied for releasing the said Truck on superdari but the same was declined by learned Judge Special Court, Amritsar vide order dated 26.10.2022 on the ground that petitioner had not been arrested in that case.

Learned counsel further contends that petitioner has been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 20.07.2023 passed in CRM-M-9872-2023 and therefore, the truck in question deserves to be released on superdari.

Having regard to the fact that petitioner has since been allowed bail, the Trial Court is directed to pass a fresh order regarding releasing the truck of the petitioner on superdari within 07 days on moving of the application.
