LISA GILL, J.

This order shall dispose off FAO-M-229-M-2005 and FAO-M-230-M-2005, which arise out of a common judgment dated 15.10.2004, passed by learned Additional District Judge, Jagadhari, whereby petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short the Act), filed by the husband was allowed and petition under Section 9 of the Act, filed by the wife was dismissed. Marriage between the parties was dissolved.

Learned counsel for the applicant-appellant submits that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties. Terms and conditions of the compromise have been reduced into writing. Copy of the final settlement dated 01.02.2023, is attached with CM-2621-CII-2023 in FAO-M-229-M-2005. Same is taken on record as A-1.

Appellant, duly identified by her counsel is present in Court. She re-affirms and verifies that the matter has been compromised and she seeks to withdraw both these appeals. Respondent, duly identified by his counsel is also present in Court. He also submits that the matter has been compromised. Parties, present in Court undertake to remain bound by the terms and conditions of the compromise.

In view of the above, CM-2621-CII-2023 is allowed and both the above mentioned appeals are dismissed as withdrawn in view of abovesaid compromise A-1.
