The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.125 dated 15.03.2022 registered under Sections 147, 149, 216, 224, 225, 186, 332, 342, 353 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (to which Sections 147, 149, 216, 224 and 225 of the IPC were added and Sections 212, 379 and 34 of the IPC were deleted lateron) at Police Station Beri, District Jhajjar.

Status report dated 01.09.2022 of Sh.Naresh Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Beri, District Jhajjar, has been filed in the Registry which is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar, submits that in pursuance of order dated 13.07.2022 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 13.07.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
