VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 25.05.2023 (Annexure P-7) passed by the Divisional Commissioner, Karnal Division, Karnal vide which the stay application has been rejected.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the main case is now listed for 20.06.2023 and since, learned counsel for respondent No.4 is present in the Court thus, the said respondent No.4 would also appear on the said date and has prayed that the main case itself be decided on 20.06.2023 or within a fixed time thereafter.

3. Learned State Counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.4 have submitted that they have no objection to the said course of action.

4. Learned counsel for respondent No.4 has further submitted that on the next date of hearing, respondent No.4 be represented before respondent No.2.

5. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to decide the appeal filed by the petitioner against the order dated 08.05.2023 within a period of one month from 20.06.2023.

6. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and respondent No.2 would decide the appeal independently and in accordance with law.
