1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the press note (Annexure P-3) and the prospectus (Annexure P-4) issued by respondent No.2.
2. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents-UT Chandigarh has submitted that the petitioner has been offered admission in Government Senior Secondary School, Sector 35, Chandigarh as per her preference and thus, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view
