Petitioners has approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of orders dated 22.05.2013, Annexures P-4 to P-7, vide which, services of the petitioners, who are temporary employees of respondent No.2, have been terminated and are sought to be replaced by temporary arrangements.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that in view that the salary is now being paid under the Rural Health Scheme, nothing survives in the petition. He submits that the petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, in case, petitioners are still left with any grievance, they may approach the Court again by filing a fresh writ petition.
