Applicant-petitioner prays for impleadment of the accused as respondents No.6 to 10.

Notice of the application.

Mr. Bikram Singh Bajwa, Advocate, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of private respondents.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed, subject to all just exceptions. The accused as mentioned in para 3 of the application are ordered to be impleaded as respondents No.6 to 10 and the amended memo of parties is also taken on record.

Main petition

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to direct respondent No.2 to take appropriate action against respondents No.6 to 10.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the State has informed that Shagandep Singh son of Baljit Singh has been declared to be proclaimed offender. Apart from that, appropriate action has been taken against respondents No.5 to 10 except respondent No.8 and challan has already been presented before the competent court. He further contends that since the necessary legal action has already been taken in the present case, no further directions are required to be issued and thus, the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the State, nothing survives in the instant petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.

Since the FIR in the present case was registered on 08.07.2019 and the challan was filed on 06.09.2020 and thereafter amended challan was presented on 24.04.2022, the learned trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.

Disposed of, accordingly.
