The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for the grant of anticipatory bail in case registered vide DDR No.40 dated 23.09.2021 under Sections 323, 324, 341, 427, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) P.S. Dirba,. District Sangrur (Annexure P-2) in FIR No.202 dated 23.09.2021 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Section 325 and 308 IPC added later on) P.S. Dirba, District Sangrur.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 31.05.2023 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Prithvi Singh, DSP, Sub Division Dirba, District Sangrur in Court today, which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioners

have joined investigation in terms of orders dated 31.05.2023 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 31.05.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
