JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondents- UOI, at the outset submits that there were four vacancies meant for unreserved candidates. Three candidates belonging to OBC category secured more marks than the candidates of General category and they occupied seats meant for unreserved. There was only one seat which was left for General category and another candidates secured more marks than petitioner, thus, he was selected.
2. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner expressed his inability to controvert the aforesaid fact.
