The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner for seeking quashing of the communication dated 03.05.2023 (Annexure P-4) whereby the permission to sell tea, pakoras and bread etc. in the Thakur Refreshment Booth has been withdrawn and the petitioner has been restrained vide aforesaid communication to carry on the said trade.

On being confronted with the fact that the petitioner has an alternative efficacious remedy of raising the aforesaid grievance before the Civil Court/appropriate forum, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition so as to approach the Civil Court and/or to take recourse to any such other appropriate remedy as may be available to him. He, however, contends that since the entire livelihood of the petitioner depends on the said Booth, he may be granted some protection so as to enable him to approach the Civil Court/appropriate Forum for redressal of his grievances. He undertakes that the petitioner shall take recourse to any of the appropriate remedy within a period of 04 weeks.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid request, the present writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn. However, considering the hardship pleaded by the petitioner, the operation of the impugned communication bearing No.1027/G.N./S.G.N.-1 dated 03.05.2023 (Annexure P-4) be not enforced against the petitioner for a period of 04 weeks from today or till the availing appropriate remedy as per law whichever is earlier.
