The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.144 dated 09.12.2022 registered under Sections 420, 120-B of IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, 2012, at Police Station Julkan, District Patiala.
