This order shall dispose of all the above mentioned three writ
petitions as the counsel for the parties agree that the issue involved therein is

Prayer in the present petitions is for directing respondent No.2 to issue Gradation Certificate to the petitioners in view of the judgment rendered by this Court in CWP No.15723-2021 titled as '*Piyusha Modi versus State of Punjab and others*'.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from Sewa Singh, Sr. Assistant, Sports Department has informed that the claim of the petitioners for issuance of Gradation Certificate is under active consideration and that the same shall be issued within a period of three weeks from today.

In view of the aforesaid statement, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) contends that the present petitions have become infructuous.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

However, the respondents shall remain bound by the statement made today in Court by learned State Counsel.
