MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners are seeking the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.224 dated 13.04.2023 for the offences under Sections 323, 324, 506, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

2. On the last date of hearing, i.e. 02.06.2023, while noticing the following submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioners and asked them to join investigation.

“While drawing the attention of this Court to the allegations levelled in the FIR, which has been annexed as Annexure P-1, learned counsel submits that no specific injury much less inviting the mischief of Section 326 IPC has been attributed to the petitioners. He submits that even

otherwise, false allegations have been levelled against the petitioners of having slapped the complainant.”

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 02.06.2023, the petitioners have joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioners having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. She, on further instructions submits that the petitioners are not required for further investigation much less for their custodial interrogation.

5. In the circumstances, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 02.06.2023 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Needless to say, in case the petitioners misuse the concession of bail granted to them, the State would be at liberty to seek cancellation of the bail granted to them.
