

DEVENDER KUMAR VS UNION BANK OF INDIA

for the petitioner.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., with a prayer for providing some more time for furnishing bail bonds before the trial Court in compliance of order dated 28.04.2023 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Panipat in appeal no.CRA-157-2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 28.04.2023, the sentence of the petitioner was suspended and he was directed to furnish bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court within one week from passing of the aforesaid order. He further submits that one more criminal complaint under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act is pending against the petitioner in which he was declared proclaimed offender and was arrested on 30.04.2023 and thereafter, released on bail on 05.05.2023 and due to said reason, he could not comply with the order dated 28.04.2023 and bail bonds could not be furnished in stipulated period.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gaurav Goel, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of Union Bank of India and opposes the prayer made by the petitioner with regard to granting extension of time for furnishing bail bonds before the trial Court.

The reason for non-compliance of order dated 28.04.2023 (Annexure P-3) as explained by the learned counsel for the petitioner is accepted and petitioner is directed to furnish bail bonds within a period of 10 days from today i.e. 31.05.2023 and same shall be accepted by the concerned Court.

Petition is Disposed of.
