This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.97 dated 06.10.2017, registered at Police Station Behram, District SBS Nagar, under Sections 336 & 506 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 (later on Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 were deleted and Section 30 of the same Act was invoked) on the basis of compromise.

Pursuant to order dated 24.11.2022, report dated 23.12.2022 has been received from the Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, SBS Nagar, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any threat, pressure or coercion.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. FIR No.97 dated 06.10.2017, registered at Police Station Behram, District SBS Nagar, under Sections 336 & 506 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 (later on Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 were deleted and Section 30 of the

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same Act was invoked) alongwith all consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom, is quashed qua the petitioner.
