SANJIV BERRY, J.

This is a petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 18 dated 30.01.2023, under Sections 406, 506 IPC, (later on added Section 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC).

2. Mr. Akash Mehta, Advocate, has entered appearance on behalf of the complainant and filed his vakalatnama in Court. The same is taken on record.

3. It is, inter alia, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance to the order dated 01.06.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

4. Learned counsel for the complainant submits that recovery of tractor has not yet been effected. However, learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Naresh Kumar, intimates that the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance to the order dated 01.06.2023 and is no more required for custodial interrogation.

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that consequent to the order dated 01.06.2023, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for custodial interrogation, interim bail granted vide order dated 01.06.2023 is hereby made absolute, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further, he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses; shall cooperate with the investigation as and when so required.

5. The petition stands allowed.
