This is a petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 177 dated 24.09.2017 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 447, 427, 420 and 109 of IPC (Section 379 of IPC added later on vide DDR No.37 dated 12.10.2017) at Police Station Sadar Jalalabad and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
