VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to do the partition among the co-sharers/petitioners as per Section 111 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887.

2. Learned State Counsel has submitted that the present writ petition for partitioning the land is not maintainable and the petitioners have never approached the authority as per the provisions of Section 111 of the Haryana Land Revenue Act.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present Civil Writ Petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail alternative remedy, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
