Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of FIR No.161 dated 01.06.2022, under Sections 302, 307, 148, 149 of IPC and Section 25/27 of Arms Act (Section 379-B of IPC added later on), at Police Station Cantonment, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar along with consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all his grievance before the trial Court at the time of framing of charge. He further submits that the petitioner is an unmarried girl who is studying Hotel Management Course and her personal exemption be granted.

Allowed as prayed for.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

In the meanwhile, the trial Court is directed to consider the application moved by the petitioner and grant her exemption from her personal appearance during trial subject to her filing affidavit to the following effect:-

1. That she will have no objection if the statements of witnesses are recorded in her absence but in the presence of her counsel.
2. That she will appear before the trial Court as & when required to do so by it.
3. That she will abide by any other condition imposed by the trial Court while granting her exemption from personal appearance.
