1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners for allotment of land to them in their respective possession shown in the list (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned State counsel has submitted that the legal notice given by the petitioners has been rejected by the authorities vide order dated 18.04.2023 and eviction orders have been passed against the petitioners on the basis of provisions of Section 16 of the Punjab (Welfare and Settlement of Landless, Marginal and Small Occupant Farmers) Allotment of State Government Land Act, 2020.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners in view of the above

seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after challenging the reply and after giving full and better particulars.

4. In view of the above-said statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
