Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that in the year 2004, the petitioner got married with Amandeep Kaur daughter of Joginder Singh and on 17.05.2007 father of the petitioner had transferred his land in the name of the wife of the petitioner, copy of transfer deed dated 17.05.2007 is Annexure P-1. It is relied that on 20.04.2016, the private respondents had taken the wife of the petitioner forcibly and got the sale deed executed in favour of respondent No.5 and till date his wife has not returned back. He had moved representation Annexure P-3 dated 11.04.2023 before respondent No.3 but till date no action thereon has been taken.

2. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Shubham Kaushik, AAG, Punjab who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and averments made in the case, without commenting on the merits of the

petition, the petition is hereby disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the Annexure P-3 expeditiously in accordance with law. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner as well.

5. It is however, made clear that any observation made above shall not affect the merits of the case nor the same will influence the concerned authority in deciding the representation in accordance with law.
