Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.77 dated 28.07.2021, under Section 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur, Punjab.

Vide order dated 18.02.2022, the petitioner was granted interim bail and subsequently thereto, the parties were referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. As per report received from the Mediator, the parties have settled the matter and counsel for the petitioner submits that the compromise quashing has already been filed vide CRM-M-58979 of 2022.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sawinder Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial

interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 18.02.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
