SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

1. By way of present writ petition, petitioners have sought issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the impugned Paper-II of Civil Services Aptitude Test (CSAT) conducted by respondent No.2 on 21.05.2023. A direction has been sought to respondent No.2 to re-conduct the examination.

2. Counsel for the petitioners submits that 38 questions in the above mentioned test are a repetition of the questions from the similar test conducted in the year 2022. According to the counsel, this casts a doubt on the efficacy of the recruiting agency. He submits that one of the petitioners has submitted a representation dated 23.05.2023 (Annexure P-14) to respondent No.2 and the petitioners would be satisfied in case Commission

looks into the representation.

3. Advance copy of the petition has been served upon the respondents.
4. Mr.B.R.Mahajan, learned Advocate General, Haryana submits that representation (Annexure P-14) would be examined within a period of 10 days from today and an appropriate order shall be passed. He further submits that till the time representation is not examined and an order is not passed, result of Paper-II of CSAT shall not be declared.
5. In view of the above statement made by learned Advocate General, Haryana, writ petition stands disposed of.
