RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

Learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, while referring to the written statement filed by the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Barara, Ambala, on behalf of respondents No.5 and 6, submits that the release certificates of 50 bonded labourers were issued by the authorities on 21.02.2019, and the release certificates as regards the bonded labourers who belong to Saharanpur, Mujaffarpur and Purnia, were also sent to the concerned District Magistrates. He further submits that, as per the SOP, even the interim compensation has been paid to the victims, who were found entitled, and as regards the victims who belong to the other States, letters have already been issued to the concerned District Magistrates. He submits that, as the necessary steps, as per the SOP, have already been taken, therefore, nothing further survives for adjudication in the petition and the same be disposed of, as such.

In view of the abovesaid statement made by learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, the petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
