AVNEESH JHINGAN , J.(Oral)

1. This petition is filed seeking regular bail in case of FIR No. 116, dated 30.8.2020, under Sections 15 and 25 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'the Act'), registered at Police Station City Jagroan, District Ludhiana.
2. One of the main ground for seeking bail is that trial is not proceeding at a decent pace.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions submits that there are total eighteen witnesses, out of which only two prosecution witnesses have been examined and an earnest effort would be made to examine the remaining prosecution witnesses within six months from the date fixed before the trial Court.
4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, learned counsel for the petitioner does not wish to press this petition.
5. Dismissed as not pressed.
6. There is no doubt that in case a request is made before the court concerned for accommodating the date for examining the prosecution witnesses, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
7. Since the main case has been dismissed as not pressed, the pending application(s), if any is rendered infructuous.
