Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to conclude the proceedings arising out of complaint No. 46-PTM dated 05.01.2021 and 1434-DCP dated 13.05.2021 (Annexure P-1) submitted before respondent No.2 by respondent No.3 vide his report dated 04.02.2021 and 26.05.2021 (Annexure P-2 and P-4) as the same has been kept pending since 04.02.2021 and 26.05.2021

On instructions from ASI Dilbag Singh, Police Station Division-8, Jalandhar, learned State counsel submits that there is already a settlement among the parties and there is no subsisting grievance.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner,
